As you know, Berkshire Community College serves a diverse population of traditional and non-traditional students from Berkshire County. Given our westernmost location, we also attract students from contiguous states, including Connecticut, Vermont, and New York.

Berkshire Community College fully endorses the tuition program approved by the Department of Higher Education, which considers a resident of New York on the same basis as a resident of Connecticut, Vermont, New Hampshire, Maine, and Rhode Island. In the fall semester of the 2022-2023 academic year, 21 residents of New York attended Berkshire Community College.

In fact, related fees generated by residents of New York strengthen both academic programs and student services at Berkshire Community College for the benefit of all students.
